

# ORDINANCE NO. 614

## AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING THE AMOUNT OF FISH TAKEN FROM VETERANS PARK POND IN HANCEVILLE, ALABAMA

### RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the City of Hanceville, Alabama (the "City") desires to protect its properties and preserve health, safety, and peaceful enjoyment for its citizens by restricting the amount of fish allowed to be taken from the Veterans Park Pond.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Hanceville, Alabama, as follows:

No person shall keep or have in their possession or on any device or in any container more than (5) five fish per day from the Veterans Park Pond.

### Section 1. Penalties.

Any person who shall violate or permits the violation of any provision of this Ordinance or shall do any act prohibited hereby shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed one hundred eighty (180) days or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day on which a violation occurs or continues to occur shall be deemed a separate offense.

### Section 2. Severability.

If any provision of this Chapter, including any exception, part, phrase, or term, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Chapter which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and in this end the provisions of this Chapter are declared severable.

### Section 9. Publication and effective date.

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
